








### Transnationality and transferability of results are fundamental in our strategic assessment

Selected projects need to fit in our Results Amplification Strategy



#### This is embedded in:

- The structure of the calls and the assessment procedure
- The approach of the quality assessment criteria





#### The structure of the calls and the assessment procedure

Better to have a single full assessment that allows for a proper evaluation of the whole project strategy.

Still, a two-phases application is preferred for calls with specific thematic restrictions.

#### The approach of the quality assessment criteria

#### **Project and partnership relevance:**

- Need to tackle common challenges and propose results that can potentially be transferred to the whole cooperation area.
- Need to show complementarities with relevant transnational strategies and initiatives.
- Geographic balance: the partnership should ideally cover the whole Programme area, from east to west.
- · Need for partners with different profiles that complement each other and work beyond their pilot areas.

#### **Cooperation character:**

- Need to demonstrate that results cannot be achieved without transnational cooperation.
- Need to show joint development of results and transferring ambition beyond the end of the project.
- Need to involve target groups with a transnational profile.

#### **Intervention logic**

- Need to include a transferring phase or plan
- Actions cannot be limited to the individual target areas: need for joint actions that produce joint results
