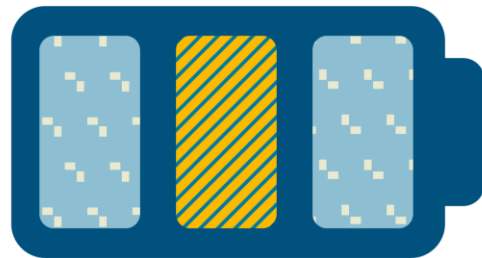

Prespa area: an example of possible synergies

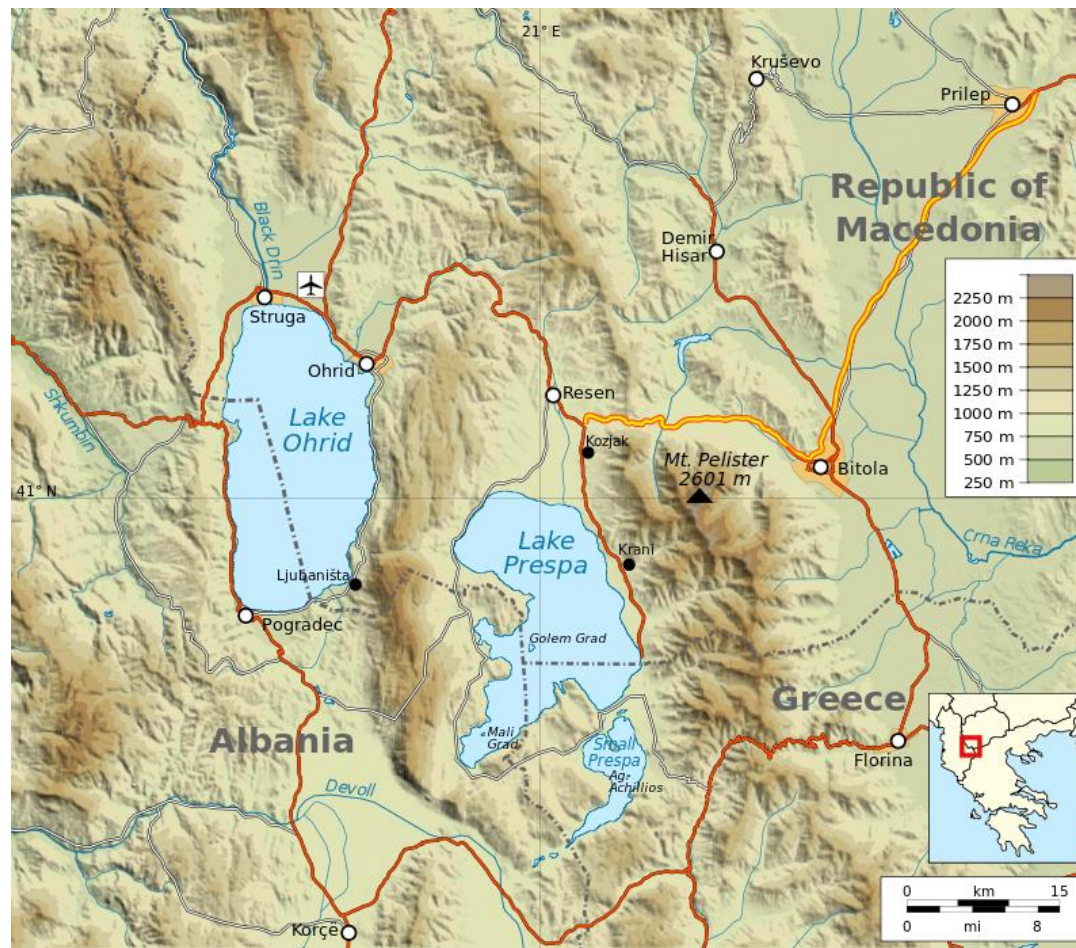
