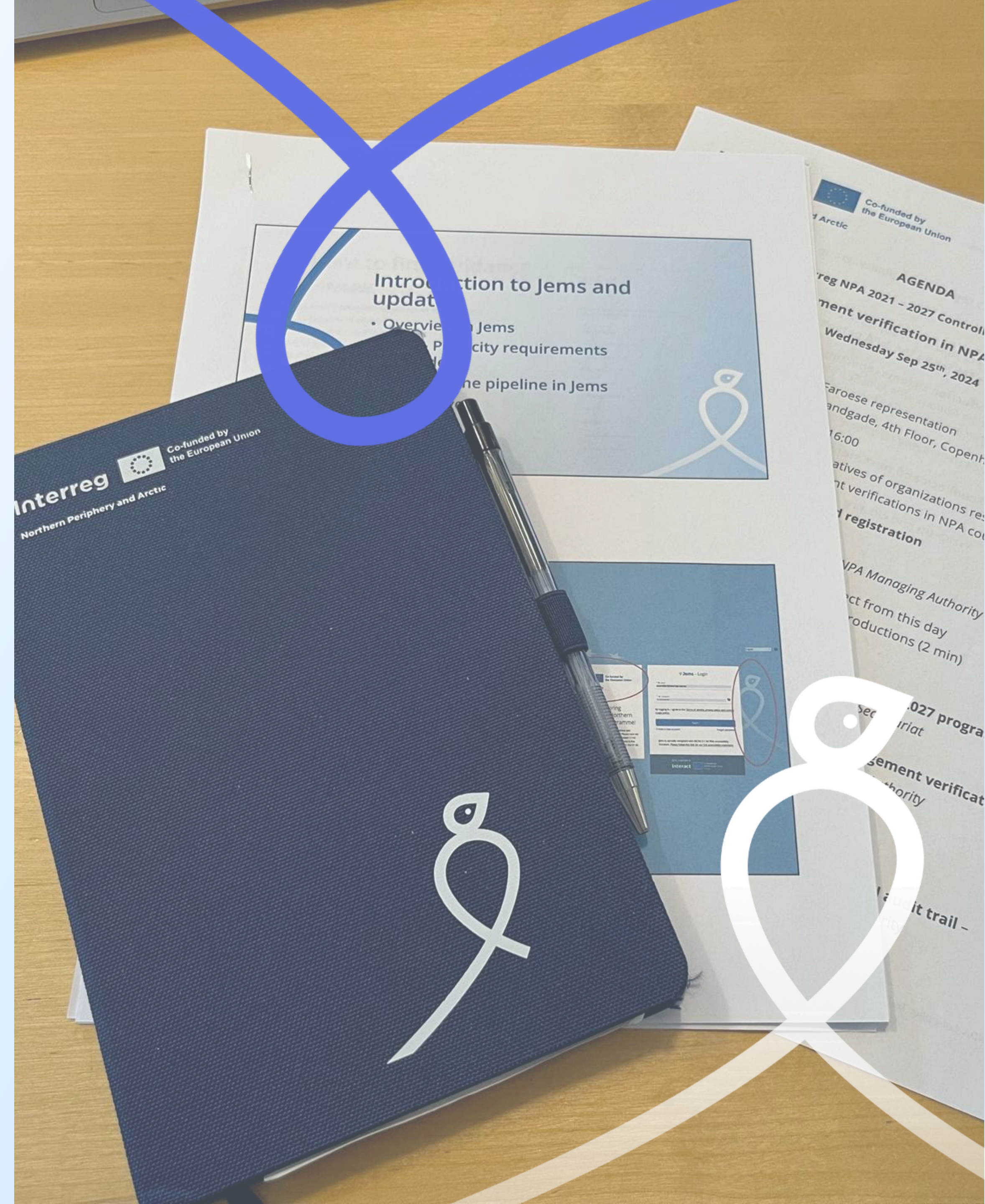

# Advantages and challenges

- Advantage of applying through this process is simple via JEMS
- SCO in the budget
- Budget for preparatory project are 50.000 EUR for 6-months and 100.000 EUR for 12-month project
- Lump sum principle
- An investment for the programme
- Matching preparatory cycle with MC meeting and main project call
- Convincing the MC, or other programme bodies
- Future plans toward end of 2021-2027
