








TERRITORIAL CONTEXT – ALCOTRA FRANCE-ITALY Programme 2021-2027


ALCOTRA – Latin Alps Cross-Border Cooperation – is one of the European cross-border cooperation programmes. Its goal is to strengthen cohesion between the French and Italian border regions.

On 26 November 2021, Prime Minister Mario Draghi and French President Emmanuel Macron signed the Quirinale Treaty in the presence of the President of the Italian Republic, Sergio Mattarella.

The Treaty seals the strategic relationship between Italy and France, a relationship deeply rooted in our common history and oriented towards the future.

On 1 February 2023, the Treaty between the Italian Republic and the French Republic for enhanced bilateral cooperation – the so-called Quirinale Treaty – officially entered into force.

- Article 10 A **Cross-Border Cooperation Committee** will be established, bringing together representatives of the relevant local authorities, existing local cross-border cooperation groups, representatives of the States and of central administrations, members of parliament, etc.
- The Committee will establish "a mechanism to identify and analyse obstacles to cooperation, as well as to monitor them until they are resolved through regulatory, legislative or diplomatic means, including the introduction of local derogations in a logic of differentiation".
- Projects financed under ISO1 will address the issues identified by the Cross-Border Cooperation Committee and will contribute to supporting its work. (Cf. ALCOTRA Operational Programme 2021/27).

OBJECTIVES ©

- **Specific Objective ISO1 Governance of cooperation**: strengthen institutional capacity and improve the management of cross-border territories (framework for all activities).
- Identify obstacles to cross-border cooperation in key sectors: health, transport, biodiversity and environment.
- Conduct a territorial survey + workshop to highlight concrete problems and define operational solutions.
- Carry out a comparative law study on these issues.
- Promote **multi-level governance** and exchange between strategies and programmes (including EUSALP, Euroregion Alps-Mediterranean).

WHY &

- The Italy—France border areas face regulatory, bureaucratic and administrative barriers limiting effective cooperation
- **strengthen governance** and cooperation bring **tangible benefits to citizens**: healthcare access, mobility, environmental protection
- create a space for dialogue among institutions, citizens and associations to enhance the Quirinale Treaty, collect local needs and propose shared solutions to both States.
- align local policies with European macro-regional strategies for greater coherence and impact.



- Promoting adaptation to climate warming and the protection of biodiversity in the Alps















After 30 years of Interreg...

- Often we do not know the right counterpart on the other side of the border
- Competencies differ between Italy and France
- Constitutional reforms have changed over time the roles and competencies of territorial authorities

Analysis and method

Structural: composite systems, types and distribution of competencies (the system, its principles, and the overall distribution of competencies)

A comprehensive overview of the distribution of competencies between the State and the Regions

In-depth focus on three topics (Health; **Environment**; Mobility and Transport)

Systematic comparison of competencies

Involvement of two researchers expert in comparative law:

1 on the Italian side (CNR ISSIRFA) 1 on the French side (DITER).







 - Biodiversity Committee
 - Health: **Synergies with the ISO1** Prosatif Go project for future collaborations
- Conducted a comparative law study
- Developed roadmaps to highlight concrete issues and operational guidelines to overcome them
- Submitted proposals and working documents to the Cross-Border Cooperation Committee (Quirinal Treaty)
- Strengthened dialogue between ALCOTRA, EUSALP, Interreg Italy-France Maritime, and other EU initiatives



Deepen the study of parallel legislative and administrative competences, **expanding to other priority topics** (employment and vocational training, data interoperability and bilingualism, risk management and climate change)
