



How we collect call data at the moment?



How will we collect data from now on



Call editing now possible for programmes

Keep.eu's intermediate backoffice (KAMUT) allows programmes to edit their call information in keep.eu

Which call fields can be edited?

Mandatory fields

Call start date, call end date, Notice text, Call to action and Link to the Call

Optional fields

Description of the call, Types of organisations eligible, Specific objectives and Geographical area

Process for accessing direct call editing

The keep.eu team will send instructions to the programmes on how to access and edit their call information in keep.eu.



Contact from keep.eu team



Head of JS or MA of a programme needs to authorise the access, or at least be informed



Programme user is asked to create a keep.eu account, if not already available



Keep.eu team grants access



Call editing in KAMUT

Keep.eu API

Keep.eu API Web service allows the access to data from keep.eu in an Open Data standard way.

Keep.eu API enables users to retrieve information about programmes (including calls), projects, and partnerships with ease.

API Web service allowing to access keep.eu data in Open standard way


