- Integrated cooperation frameworks endorsed by the European Council;
- Addressing common challenges faced by a defined geographical area relating to Member States and EU-candidate countries and third countries;
- Contributing to achievement of economic, social and territorial cohesion;
- Serve as open and agile platforms for strategic networking;
- Based on MLG and cross-sectoral principle, MRS help to coordinate joint policies and actions far beyond physical or psychological barriers;
- Can be supported by Cohesion Policy funding instruments and other EU/national/regional funding sources.

Western Balkans R&I Information Hub

- EUSDR Priority Area: PA 7 Knowledge Society
- Horizon Europe funded project, budget: 5 Million EURO
- EUSDR member states: Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Germany, Montenegro, Serbia
- EUSAIR participating countries: Italy, Albania, North Macedonia
- Stimulating, monitoring, and supporting the cooperation in research, education, and innovation
- Scale up common efforts of the European Union and the Western Balkans – for cooperation on Innovation, Research, Education, Culture, Youth and Sport.





















Examples of EUSDR & EU Enlargement

Danube Region Multimodal Corridors

- EUSDR Priority Area: PA 1b Rail-Road-Air Mobility
- Development of an interconnected and integrated transport system in the Danube Region
- Closing infrastructural, technological, and legislative gaps alongside the TEN-T to improve accessibility, cross-border flows, and regional connectivity
 - Assessing growth, jobs, and climate impacts of 2022–2030 corridor investments aligned with EU transport policy
 - Identifying and supporting additional multimodal corridors with macro-regional added value (e.g. Black Sea – Northern Adriatic Corridor)

















Examples of EUSDR & EU Enlargement

Adaptation to Climate Change

- EUSDR Priority Area: PA 4 Water Quality
- Focuses on climate change and sharing experience and best practices in climate change adaptation emphasising (green) water retention measures, which contribute to better water quality and water availability in the Danube Region:
 - Small water and nutrient retention measures (OPTAIN)
 - Local water retention measures (LIFE LOGOS 4 WATERS).
 - Creation of water balance mode for the whole Danube River Basin (Danube Water Balance).
 - Innovative water management initiatives (DALIA)
 - Improving the management of sediment quantity and quality (DanubeSediment_Q2)
 - Restoration of river banks and riparian areas (RESTORIVER)
