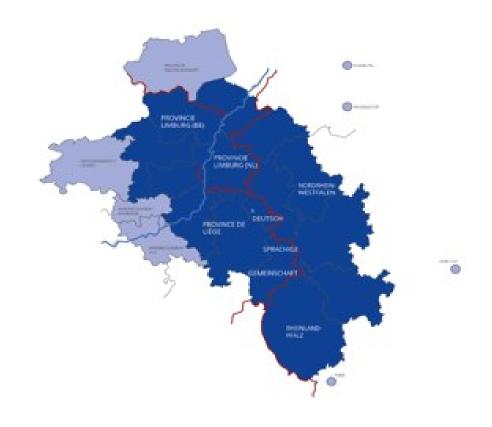

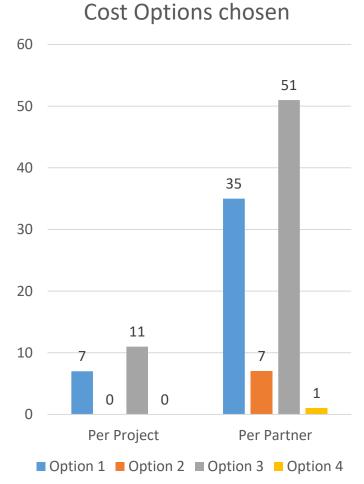

## 4 Cost Options

- 1. Office & admin flat (15 % staff), Travel & accommodation flat (1.5 % staff)
- 2. Office & admin flat (15 % direct), Travel & accommodation flat (1.5 % staff)
- 3. 40 % other costs based on staff costs
- 4. 20 % other costs (other than direct costs) based on staff costs







## 40 % flat rate on staff costs

- Standard scale of unit costs for staff costs (Art. 56 CPR).
- Hourly rate established with first full month based on salary (per country)
- Initial report: Payslip & Time sheet
- Later reports: Time sheet

# Focus checking reports

#### Control

- Project Officers
- Additional check by FO on hourly rate
- more focus on content, also because costlines tell us less about content now

#### Content:

- Sometimes hours and partner report on activities don't match elaboration of activities
- No occasion that staff does not seem to be performing

#### Issues:

- Coming from reporting all expenditure, beneficiaries do not understand what they need to and do NOT need to report.
- Difference between external expertise and secondment
