

#### **EXAMPLE OF A MICROPROJECT: The shared history of the Canfranc railway**



- Association « CANFRANC 1928 »
- Association « MÉMOIRE D'ASPE »
- Until now, the citizens of both valleys have had cultural activities that are not connected unless the local councils organise joint activities.

The project consists of sharing a common cultural activity based on the recovery of the collective memory of the valleys near Canfranc and Aspe in relation to their shared history surrounding the construction of the Canfranc Railway Line.





- CTP is INTERREG POCTEFA Managing Authority (2007-2013, 2014-2020, 2021-2027)
- CTP was founded in 1983. In all these years CTP has played a major role boosting cooperation between Spain, France and Andorra, more than 650 Km of border.

### Call for proposals of microprojects 2022:

- Main goal of the call for proposals: Boosting and revitalising cross-border cooperation between Spain, France and Andorra, bringing Europe closer to its citizens.
- Any type of legal entity. Minima 2 from 2 different countries, Spain, France or Andorra.
- Only expenses linked to direct cost except human ressources. Funding of 100%.
- Maximun 25.000 Euros.
- One of the criteria was to be new receiving funds for cross border cooperation.
- Domains: culture, tourism, sport, education, youth, social action, health, agriculture,
  agri-food sector and environment.

- Strengthen community life through small cross-border initiatives
- Stimulate the economic activities of SMEs in the cross-border area;
- Develop local initiatives that contribute to the development of the territory (tourism, mountains, coastline, etc.);
- Promoting environmental protection;
- Strengthening common identity, cross-border citizenship and participation in the cross-border region;
- Intensifying contacts through exchanges and greater mobility of the population;
- Removing obstacles to cross-border cooperation;
- Stimulating cross-border social activities.
