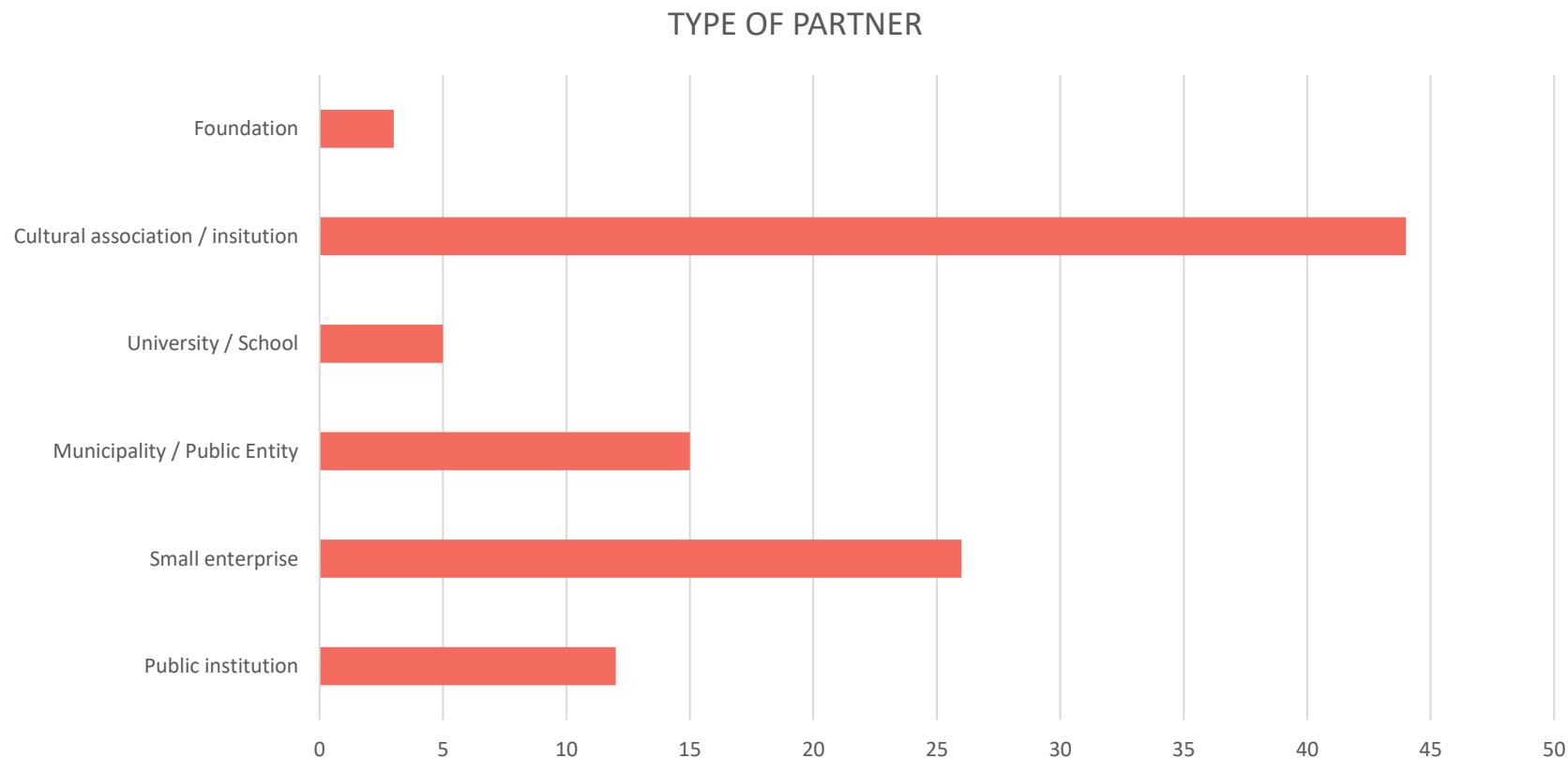

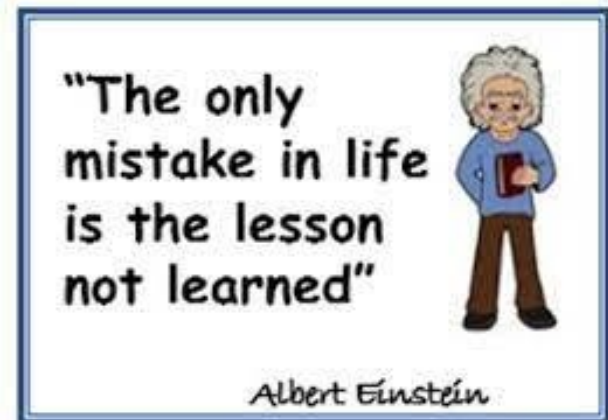


LESSONS LEARNT

Small projects – participants are mostly small local associations and small entities, the one that normally are not participating to Interreg standard; those small associations are resulting also more succesful then other types of beneficiaries, which are on the contrary more used in working on standard Interreg. Small projects are oriented to short-term and concrete results, projects shall be structured differently from the standard one.

Single-beneficiary project – these type of projects typically have faster and more streamlined implementation. They involve fewer budget transfers and face reduced administrative burdens. Budget to be managed by this kind of project shall be limited but they have demonstrated to produce quick and concrete, tangible results.

Pre financing – it's needed by small private associations/institutions and SMEs, but guarantees are not easy to be obtained. There is a need to find prior an ad hoc agreement with banks and credit institutions to help the access to the pre financing.
