

Article 3: Specific objectives for the ERDF and the Cohesion Fund

PO 1: A more competitive and smarter Europe by promoting innovative and smart economic transformation and regional ICT connectivity by:


- (i) developing and enhancing research and innovation capacities and the uptake of advanced technologies;
- (ii) reaping the benefits of **digitisation** for citizens, companies, research organisations and public authorities;
- (iii) enhancing sustainable growth and competitiveness of SMEs and job creation in SMEs, including by productive investments;
- (iv) developing **skills** for smart specialisation, industrial transition and entrepreneurship;
- (v) enhancing digital connectivity

Focus of support in PO1

- In the context of PO 1: R & I is not about "excellence" but more about "catching up"
- Applied research
- Place based
- Uptake-, testing-, development of new technologies and solutions by firms, public administrations and citizens, in relation to societal challenges climate change, circular economy or health, better public services, value chains
- **Diffusion of** knowledge, technologies, innovations and by digitalisation
- **Development of skills** for smart specialisation, industrial transition and entrepreneurship.
- Linking regional research and innovation actors to industrial stakeholders from different Member States should stimulate interregional cooperation in **new cross-border value chains**.
- Complementarity with other EU funding programmes
- Shall **build on smart specialisation strategies** that reflect the strengths and assets of the regions concerned.
- Interregional initiatives in the framework of smart specialisation shall promote shared strategic interest and common priorities.
- Specific attention to be paid to development of capabilities of less developed regions to allow them to move towards higher innovation performance by triggering necessary structural reforms, improving their R&I systems and governance of their innovation eco-systems(in terms of quadruple helix).
- It is also essential to identify relevant bottlenecks for innovation creation and diffusion.




