




Un patrimoine hydraulique riche et diversifié




Fesquia

- [**MAPA**](#) co-financed by **Interreg Italy – Croatia** project that is strengthening the protection status of three (Island of Silba, Parco del Conero, Foce Trigno) existing Protected Areas as Marine Adriatic Parks (MAPA) with the direct involvement of the local communities to strengthen local influence on nature protection; ensure the long-term sustainability of measures and create a balance between nature protection and the life of the community.
- Projects co-financed by **Interreg Euro-MED** focusing on island solutions: 1) [**EcoMedIslands**](#) optimizes islands waste management by rolling out a circular economy strategy, cutting waste at the source and boosting reuse and recycling. 2) [**MED H2**](#) supports Mediterranean islands in managing water sustainability through the conservation of tangible and intangible hydraulic heritage. 3) [**LooP Zone**](#) boosts circular economy practices through Low Plastic Zones in islands. 4) **WATERISE** provides wastewater and rainwater treatment solutions for reuse in overtourism in islands. Including two test projects: [**AQUAMAN**](#) evaluates aquatic systems for the mitigation of water scarcity in Mediterranean islands and coastal tourist destinations under severe pressure. [**CO2 PACMAN**](#) supports Mediterranean islands in their transition to climate neutrality.


