Generative AI for Interreg communication

Overview

In recent years, generative AI tools have surged in development, delivering updates at an unprecedented pace. These tools enable creators to produce a wide range of content, from text and images to videos and even music. At the same time, they raise important questions about their impact on Interreg communication and highlight the need for a basic understanding of AI models and their capabilities.

Who is it for?

The training primarily targets programme communication officers, but anyone working for an Interreg programme is welcome to sign up.

What will I learn?

This training aims to build basic capacity among Interreg programme staff to better understand and use various AI models and tools for communication purposes. By the end of the training, participants will be equipped with the knowledge needed to generate and refine communication outputs from start to finish using AI tools.

How long does the training take?

It typically takes 13 hours (within three weeks) to complete all the components of the training.

How do I get my certificate?

We issue your certificate when you have completed all the mandatory components of the training and have successfully completed a simple final task – an assignment to work with AI for a specific communication service or product.
