Regular public buses operate between the airport and various points in Belgrade, including New Belgrade where Sava Centar is located. The journey takes 30-40 minutes depending on the route and all public transport in Belgrade is completely free since January 2025. This is the most economical option for budget-conscious travellers.

[No. 72](#) to the stop: Zeleni Venac (city centre)

Brankov most (close to the venue)

[No. 72N](#) for the night arrivals: stop Republic square

- Taxi service

### Use only official taxis with official voucher system!

E-kiosk locations for the voucher: Three e-kiosks in the baggage claim area.

Taxis are just outside of the arrival area.

In majority of cases can be paid by the card, however cash payment is recommended.

Fixed prices:

Zone 1: 2700 RSD (to the venue) approx.: 25 EUR

Zone 2: 3500 RSD (to the city centre) approx.: 30 EUR

### By train

The nearest major railway station is Beograd Centar (Prokop).

There are multiple options to the city centre from the train station. Let us know and we will advise you



- Public transport

Sava Center is also well connected by public transport. The most convenient lines to the complex are:

**Bus lines:** 95, 17, 18, 70, 74, 88, 601, 27E, 35.

**Tram lines:** E1, E6, 9A.

### Arriving by car

Sava Centar is conveniently accessed via the **E-75 highway**. Parking is available at the venue and nearby commercial areas, such as the Ušće shopping centre. Please allow extra time during peak traffic.

### Getting around Belgrade

The New Belgrade area is easy to navigate. Public buses and trams cover most routes and are free of charge.

Walking is convenient in the immediate Sava Centar area.

### Travel tips

Currency: Serbian dinar (RSD); Exchange rate: 1 EUR=116-117 RSD

Card payments widely accepted

Cash machines at the arrival area at the airport

Always use official taxis or reputable apps to avoid unregulated offers.

Please remember to bring your passports with you. For most EU passports, automatic passport control machines are available, which should make the process quicker and smoother.

As there is no EU roaming arrangement, we recommend switching off your mobile data to avoid unexpected charges. If needed, you will find several SIM card options available for purchase in the baggage claim area upon arrival.
