

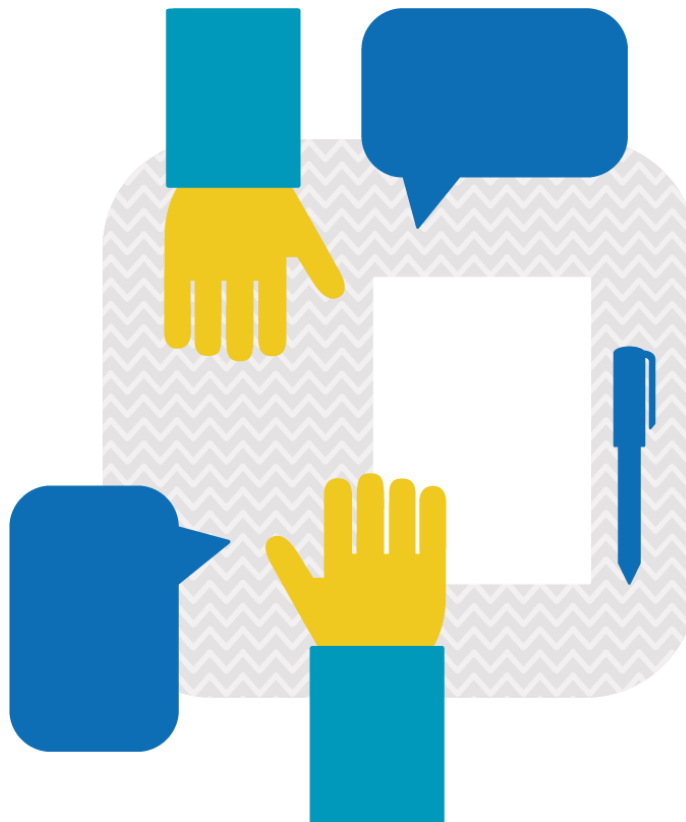

Outlines

Building on the discussions held during the three online events in September, this two-day in-person meeting will provide an opportunity to continue, deepen and consolidate the work on the respective HIT fields. The meeting will focus on the HIT Intervention Logic, Capitalisation & Synergies and HIT Budget, with particular attention to how these elements can be translated into practical and harmonised approaches for programmes.

The meeting will combine short introductions with interactive discussions, feedback and joint reflection, allowing participants to work directly on the HIT proposals developed so far.

The first day will start with the HIT Intervention Logic. Participants will review the updated Intervention Logic factsheet, discuss remaining open points and work towards its finalisation. The discussion will then move from the conceptual framework to its practical application, looking at how the Intervention Logic is reflected in the HIT application form and considering the feedback received through the questionnaire.

The afternoon will broaden the discussion to Capitalisation & Synergies, focusing on how these elements should be reflected in the application form. Participants will review the proposed approach, provide feedback and discuss the questionnaire results and any remaining issues requiring further clarification.

The second day will continue the work on Capitalisation & Synergies before turning to the HIT Budget. The budget sessions will introduce the proposed way of reflecting budget-related information in the application form and provide substantial time for discussion, feedback and consideration of the questionnaire responses.

Objectives

The meeting aims to consolidate and further develop the HIT approach, building on the previous online discussions and participant feedback. It will support a common understanding and practical application of HIT Intervention Logic, Capitalisation & Synergies and HIT Budget, including how these elements are reflected in the HIT application form.

The meeting will take place at Zonar Zagreb. The hotel is located approximately 1.5 km from the city centre, 3.1 km from Zagreb Main Railway Station and around 18 km from Zagreb Airport. The nearest tram stop is approximately 800 metres from the hotel.

Travel

Zagreb is easily accessible by plane and is also well connected by international rail and coach services. International train connections include, among others, services to and from Ljubljana, Vienna and Budapest.

By plane

Franjo Tuđman Airport Zagreb is located approximately 18 km from the meeting venue. There are two main public transport options between the airport and the city: The Pleso Prijevoz airport shuttle operates between Zagreb Airport and the Zagreb Central Bus Station. The journey takes approximately 35–40 minutes. Alternatively, ZET bus line 290 connects the airport with Kvaternikov trg and Velika Gorica; the journey between the airport and Zagreb takes approximately 45–50 minutes.

By train

Zagreb Main Railway Station (Zagreb Glavni kolodvor) has national and international rail connections. From the Main Railway Station, tram line 9 in the direction of Ljubljana connects directly to Trešnjevački trg. From Trešnjevački trg, the meeting venue is approximately a 10-minute walk. Tram line 9 currently serves both Glavni kolodvor and Trešnjevački trg.

Accommodation

Participants are kindly asked to arrange and book their accommodation individually. As the meeting will take place at Zonar Zagreb, participants may wish to stay directly at the meeting venue.
